I, MARGOT GARANT, as the Mayor of the Village of Port Jefferson, pursuant to the powers vested in me by the Code of the Inc. Village of Port Jefferson and Article 2-B, Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law, hereby certify

THAT, in order to preserve the public safety and property of the Village residents,

NOW DOES HEREBY ORDER:


The Village continues under a STATE of EMERGENCY; and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

- A. That all conditions and directives contained in Local Emergency Orders 1-2020, 2-2020, 3-2020, 4-2020, 5-2020, 6-2020 and 8-2020 are renewed, continued and extended in full force and effect; and
- B. Pursuant to NY Executive Law Section 24 and Port Jefferson Village Code Section 245-27, effective Friday May 8, 2020 at 5:00PM, standing or parking of vehicles is hereby prohibited on Main Street in the downtown business district (both sides) on Saturdays and Sundays. Parking for curbside customer pick up only.


Except as stated above, this Order shall be effective IMMEDIATELY and shall remain in effect until removed by further order of the Mayor.

Failure to obey this order is a criminal offense, punishable by law under New York State Executive Law §24(5) and Port Jefferson Village Code Section 1-2.
