The entity using the property must comply with the Incorporated Village of Port Jefferson Use of Facility Standards. The entity must maintain at a minimum the following, giving evidence of same to the Incorporated Village of Port Jefferson in the form of a Certificate of Insurance, copy of the General Liability Declarations Page and copy of the Additional Insured Endorsement and provide 30 days notice of cancellation, non-renewal or material change. New York State licensed carrier is preferred; any non-licensed carriers will be accepted at the Municipalities discretion. The insurance carrier must have an AM Best Rating of at least A- IX. Workers Compensation and NYS Disability is required for any entity that has employees that will be working on the premises.
