Action Items:

- 1. Approve the minutes of January 4, 2021.
- 2. At the request of Mayor Garant, approve Phase 3 of the proposal by Global Common in evaluating the potential future of uses of the Port Jefferson Power Plant at a cost of \$10,000.00.
- 3. Resolution authorizing the Mayor to enter into a Development Agreement with Port Jefferson Crossing LLC (Conifer) relative to the Village's construction of Station Street, and the installations and related utility easements to effectuate the Village's Planning Board site plan approvals for the Project Site at Suffolk County Tax Map District 206, Section 21, Block 6, Lots 7, 9.2, 9.3 and 15.
- 4. Approve a license from Maggio Environmental pursuant to Chapter 151 of the Village Code within the Village of Port Jefferson from January 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021.
- 5. Approve a resolution to authorize the Village Assessor to apply the 2020 Final Assessment roll senior and disability exemptions to the 2021 tentative and final Village Assessment Rolls without requiring taxpayers to file renewal exemption applications, or any related paperwork, pursuant to gubernatorial executive order as a result of the Covid pandemic.
- 6. At the request of Brian MacMillan, approve a 5-year golf cart lease with Fairway Golf Cart Car Corp at a monthly payment of \$5,685.46 which terminates the remaining responsibility of the current lease.
- 7. Approve a change order for F&F Concrete to furnish and install an electrical GFCI receptacle in the Barnum Lot at a cost of \$600.00.
- 8. Approve a change order for F&F Concrete to install 2 curb stops for the parking spaces where the charging station is located at a cost of \$800.00.
- 9. Approve a resolution Certifying the Account of Unpaid Taxes and Authorizing a Tax Sale.
