## VILLAGE OF PORT JEFFERSON Local Law No. \_\_ of the year 2024 A local law be it enacted by the: Board of Trustees of the Village of PORT JEFFERSON as follows:

## **PURPOSE**

A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING A PROPERTY TAX LEVY IN EXCESS OF THE LIMIT ESTABLISHED IN GENERAL MUNICIPAL LAW § 3-c.

Section 1. Legislative Intent. It is the intent of this local law to allow the Village of Port Jefferson to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2024, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the "tax levy limit" as defined in General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 2. Authority. This local law is adopted pursuant to subdivision 5 of General Municipal Law § 3-c, which expressly authorizes a local government's governing body to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by the adoption of a local law approved by a vote of sixty (60%) percent of said governing body.

Section 3. Tax Levy Limit Override. The Board of Trustees of the Village of Port Jefferson, County of Suffolk, State of New York, is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing June 1, 2024, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 4. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article, chapter or part of this local shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section, article, chapter or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section 5. This local law shall become effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
